YOUTH GUN DEER HUNTING RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Chippewa Rod and Gun Club, Inc. offers a Youth Gun Deer Hunting Recognition Program in an effort to encourage, recognize, and honor young deer hunters for their successful efforts.

This program is open to youth of club families and area Hunter Education Graduates. To enter, youth must be 12 to 17 years of age.

All youth, submitting their entry, will receive a special 8 ½" x 11" certificate, suitable for framing, that recognizes their successful hunt.

The Chippewa Rod and Gun Club, Inc. will place all program entries into a drawing for a special plaque. One young hunter will be selected annually, at random, for this award. That contestant will be invited to the club's April meeting to be recognized by the members and be presented with their plaque. The winning youth and family will be asked to share their hunting experience. The youth will be encouraged to invite one of his/her Hunter Education Instructors to join them that evening.

Eligible youth can enter a deer from the October Youth Gun Deer Hunt, the November Gun Deer Season, the Muzzleloader Season, or the December Antlerless only Hunt, pending final gun season rules and dates. All entries must be postmarked by January 1st.
